MEMBERSHIP FORM

The mission of MCIRR is to: 1) coordinate educational and organizational efforts that build capacity within Michigan's immigrant advocacy community; 2) support immigrants' rights in federal, state, and local policy; and 3) promote a more positive and inclusive atmosphere for immigrants and refugees in Michigan.

Groups recognized as non-profit, religious, educational, or charitable organizations under the Internal Revenue Code that affirm the purpose and work of MCIRR may become member organizations of MCIRR. Member Organizations shall have one vote per organization in all MCIRR voting matters. Individuals and organizations that are not eligible for membership in the MCIRR that affirm the purpose and work of MCIRR may participate in all MCIRR activities and are encouraged to do so but may not vote or hold positions on the Steering Committee. These individuals and organizations may be referred to as "supporters" of MCIRR. (Article IV, Section 2 of the MCIRR Bylaws).
